


OVERVIEW

At MOPEX, we strive to bring out the potential in each of our students. Tutoring – Elementary

 Our focus for our elementary students is to make sure they are properly prepared for high school. This means bringing them up to the standard of learning for their age group, filling the gaps in their understanding of the academic curriculum, and giving them the best head start to grade 9 and beyond. A focus on the foundational subjects (Math, Reading, and Writing) is the basis for learning and mastering other subjects offered in elementary school.

At the elementary level, we focus on:

- Mathematics
- Reading
- Language (Writing, Grammar, and Creative Thinking skills)
- Problem Solving Skills

Tutoring – High School

 High school students spend the majority of their high school career adjusting to a more mature learning environment, a heavier workload, and planning their post-secondary education. At MOPEX, we mentor our students from the very beginning by assisting them (with their parents) in choosing their courses and planning their academic pathway to university or college. Unlike our elementary students, we work alongside our high school student's current curriculum, offering extra help and tutoring in the courses they take each semester.

At the high school level, we offer tutoring in:

- Mathematics, Functions, Advanced Functions, Calculus, Data Management, etc.
- English (Grade 9-12)
- Science, Physics, Chemistry
- Literacy Test Prep / EQAO Prep.
- Civics & Careers
- SAT Preparation
- Homework Help / Study Skills

Day School – Elementary (9:00 AM – 2:00 PM))



Our day school program offers students an opportunity to learn in a safe and nurturing environment, and at a pace that is best suited to their level of learning. We strive to preserve the innocence of children and encourage them in the morals and values only God's Word provides. At MOPEX, we do not keep our students at a base level, but rather work alongside parents to help all of our day school students reach an academic level above the provincial standard. By building a proper academic foundation early on, learning and understanding more difficult concepts in high school, college, or university becomes easier. Coupled with a solid Biblical foundation, students are equipped with the wisdom they need to overcome the challenges they may face in the future.
